Task 6.2: Mapping and benchmarking of research funding programmes

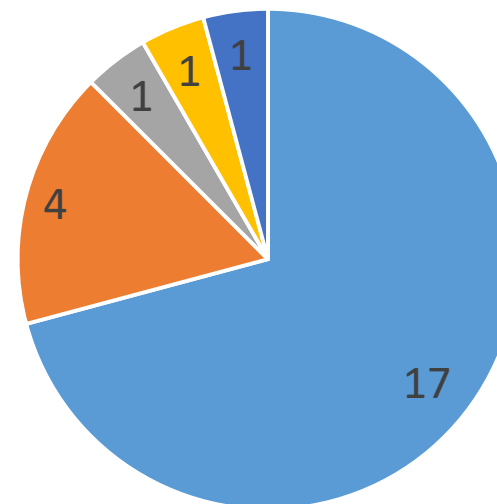
Objectives

- Assess the national research funds and programmes across participating EU and non-EU MS-related to raw materials, including information on research themes, financial possibilities, and duration of programme.
- The questionnaire in 2018
- From 21 funding organizations, 19 respondents have been received, which represent a participation of 90%. An additional 5 funding organizations, not partners of ERA-MIN 2 consortium answer the questionnaire, so the total number of respondents included in the survey is 24 funding organizations.

Who are the funders?

When looking into the composition of the responded funding organisations the majority represents funding agency - 17, 4 ministries, 1 research council, 1 secretariat of government and 1 scientific institution.

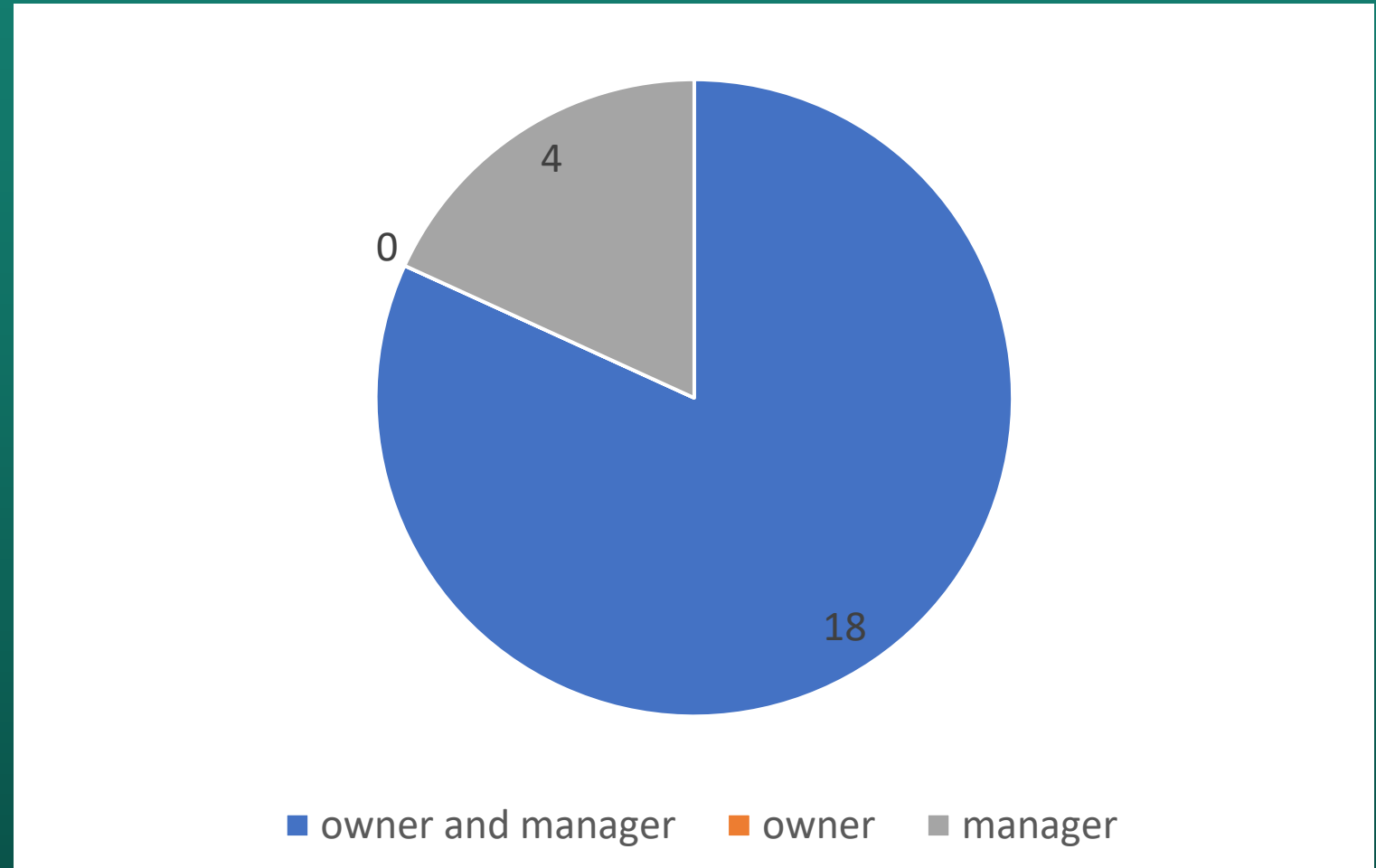
Type of organisation

The majority of partners are in the role of programme owner and programme manager (18). 4 of them have a mandate only to manage the programme.

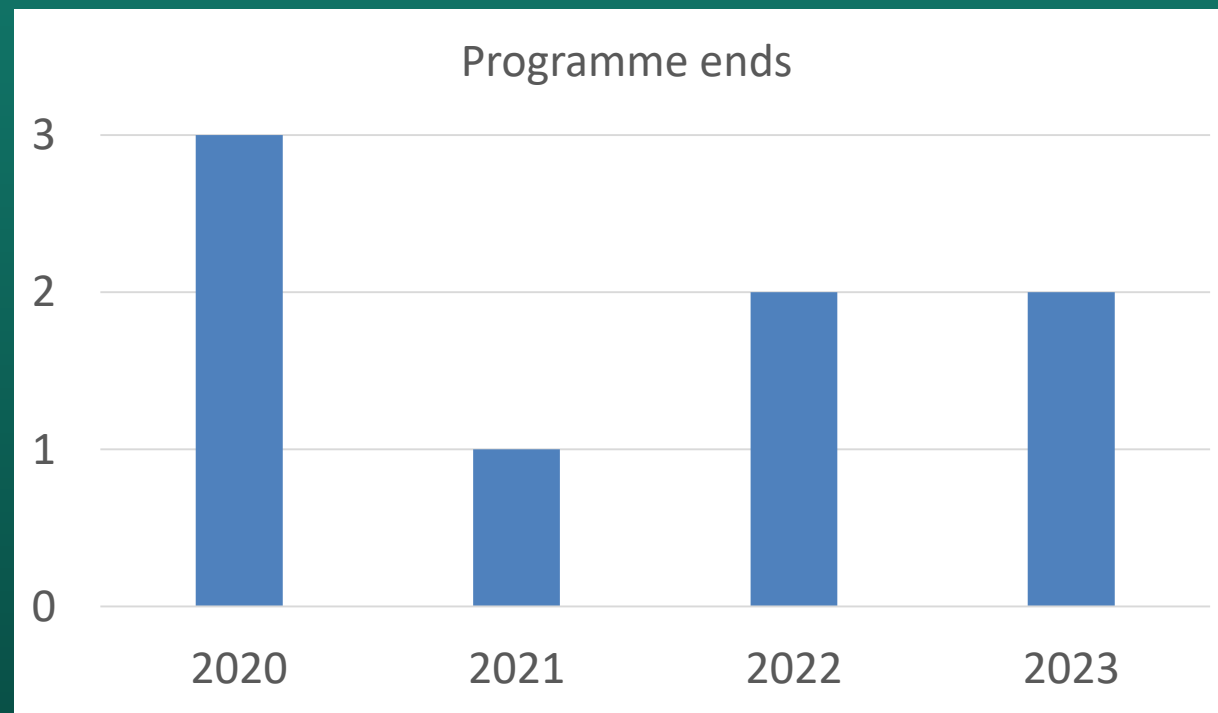


Duration of the programme

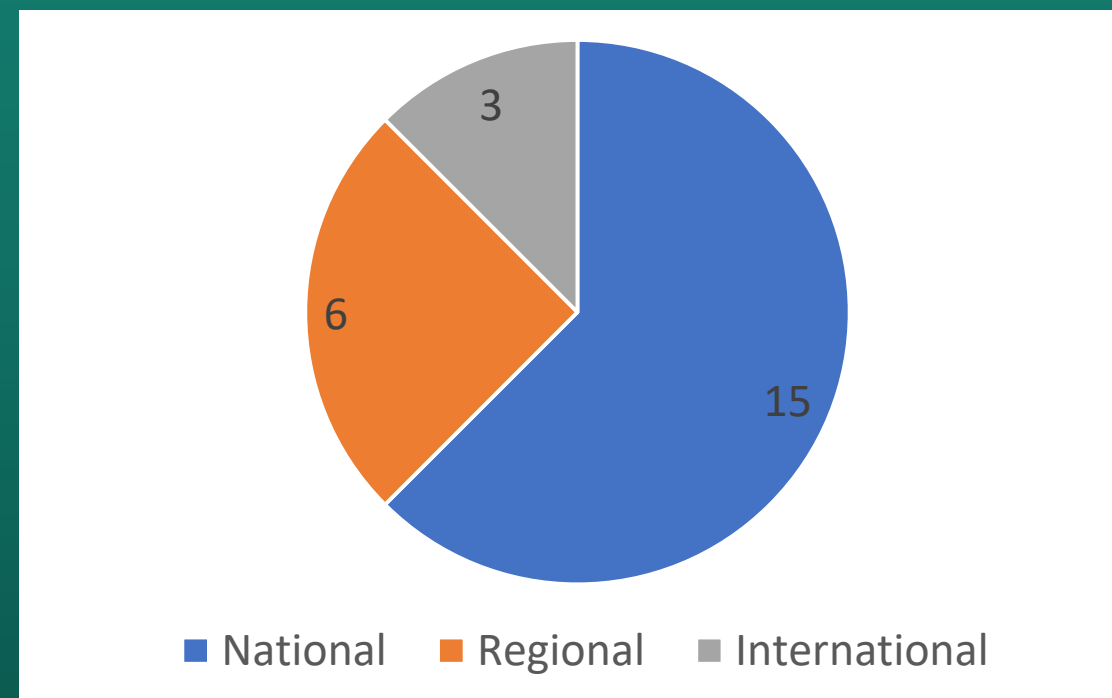

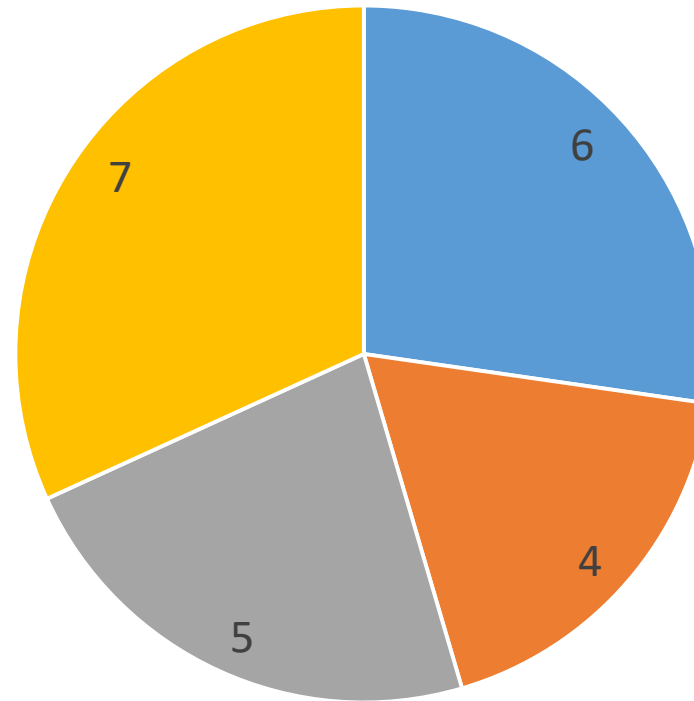

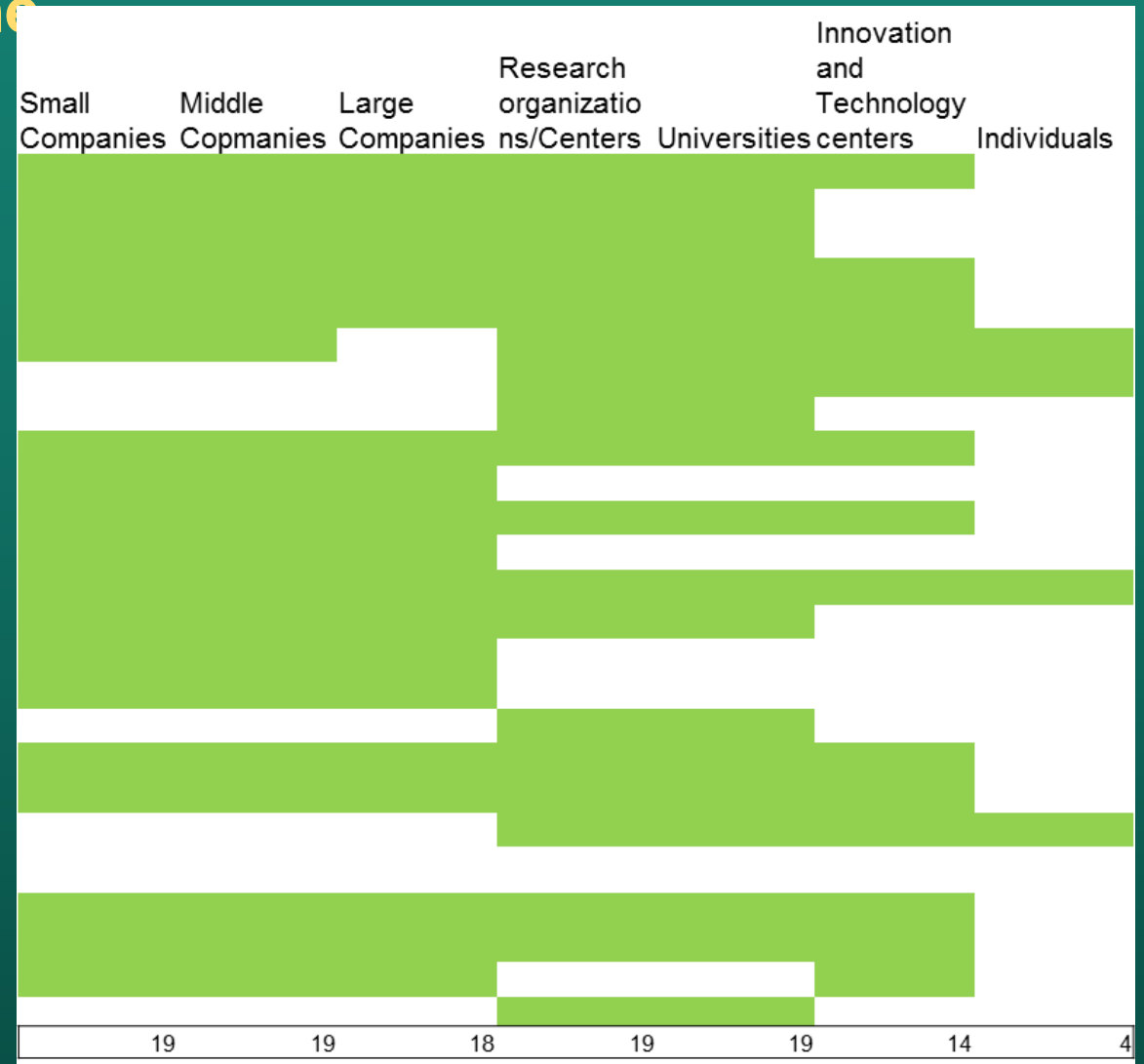

Targets or beneficiaries of the programme

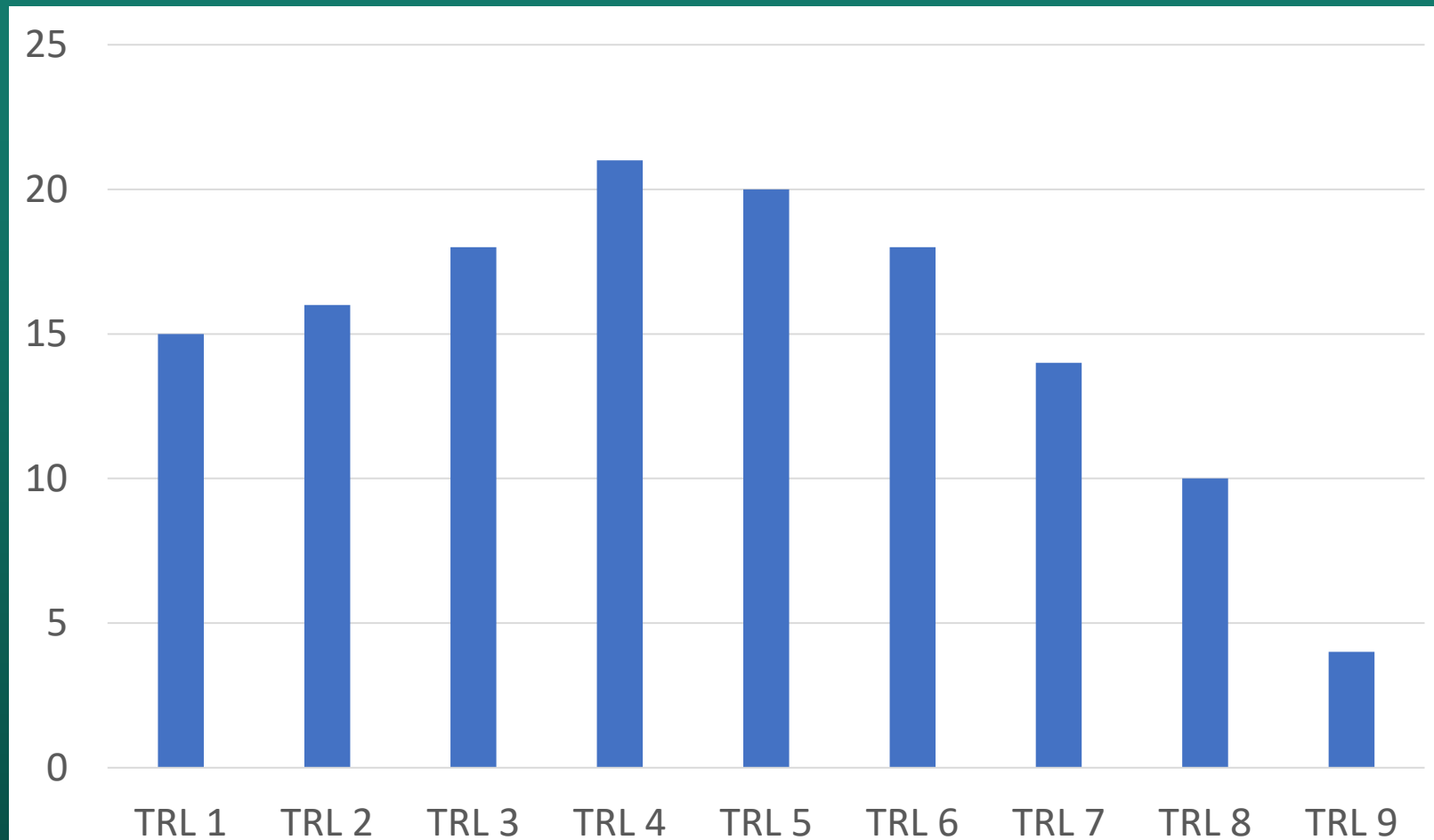


When asking who the target beneficiaries of the programme are, only 4 funding organizations are allowed to fund individuals.

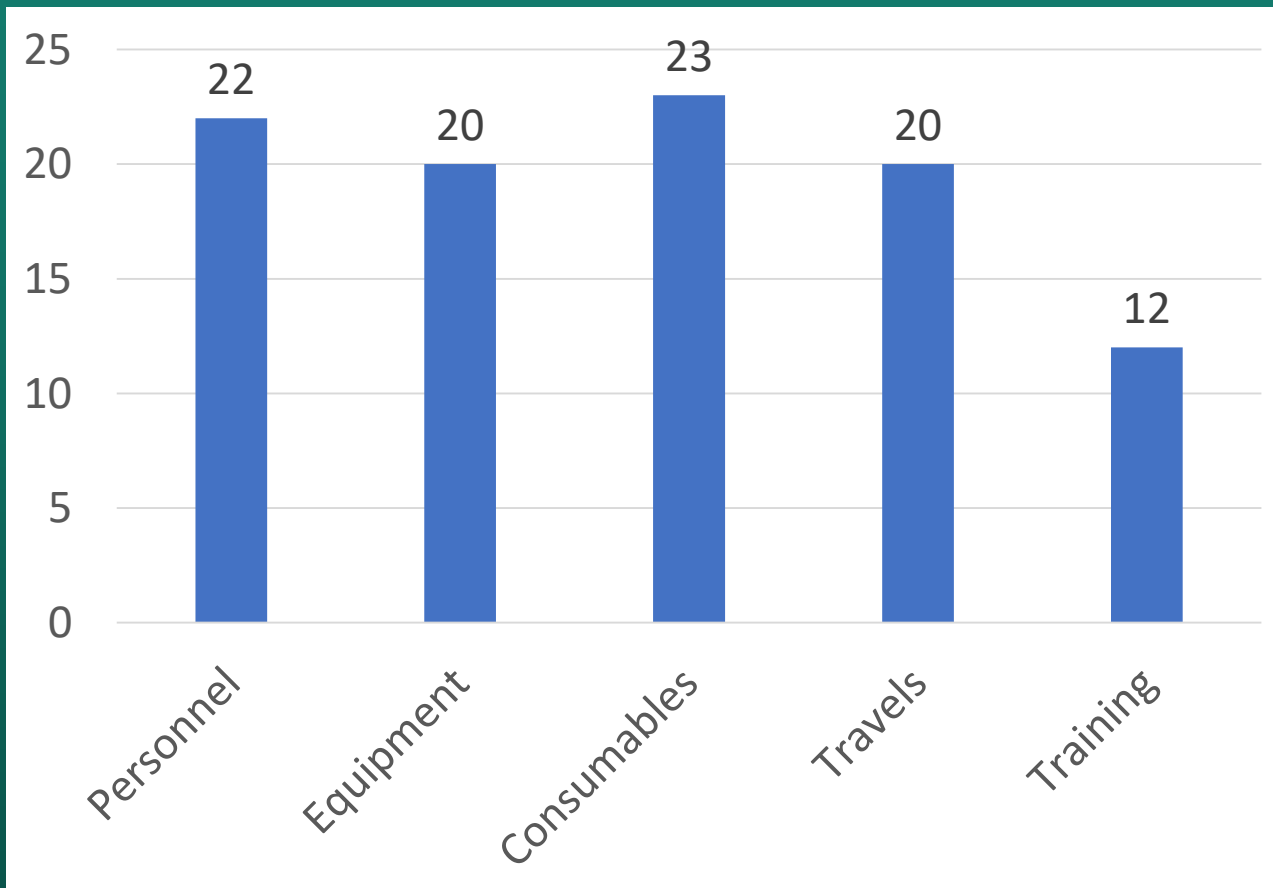
We can split participants into two very equal groups those who are more focused on universities and research organizations and those more into the business sector.



Eligible TRL range for funding

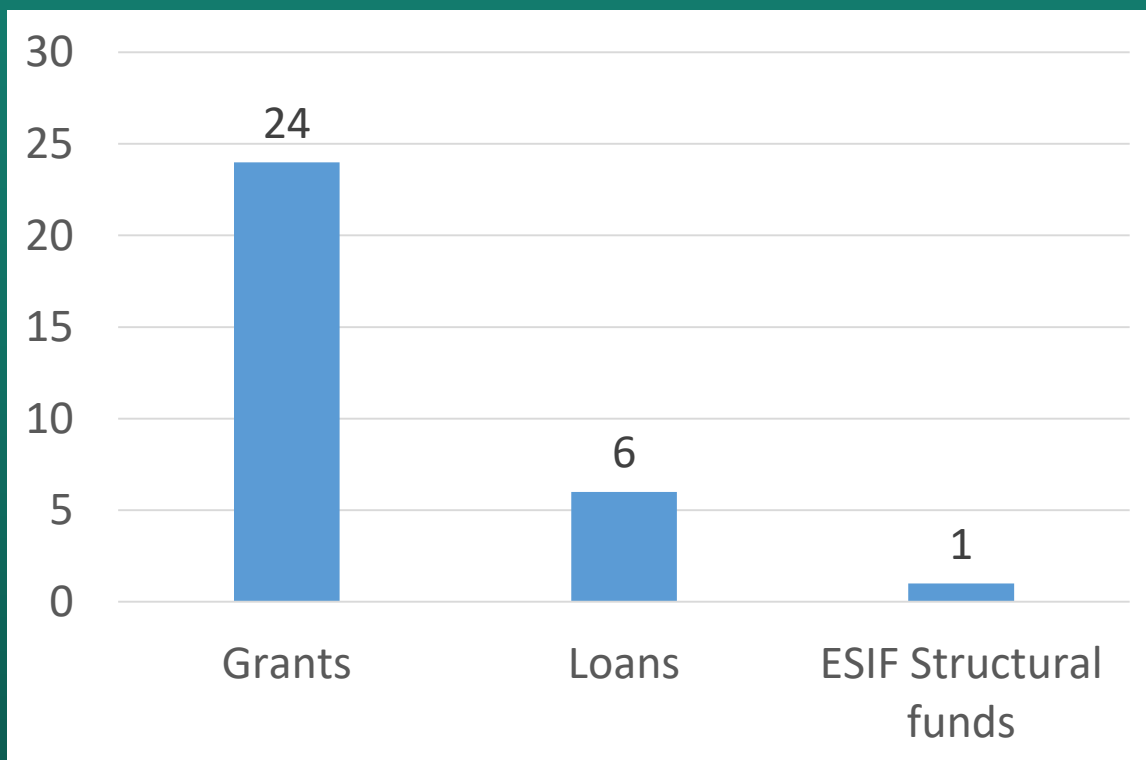


Eligible costs



Funding organisations are more harmonized considering eligible costs. Most of them agree to fund most consumables (23), personnel costs (22), equipment (20) and travels (20) but only a minority (12) can fund trainings.
